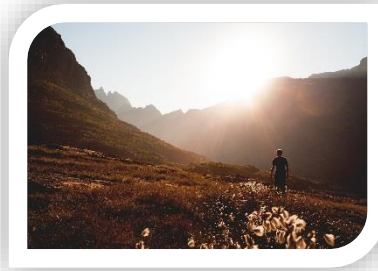




Trekking tour around Verona



Detailed itinerary

Day 1: Welcome in Verona

Arrival in **Verona** – Check-in at the Hotel and relax. Meet and short briefing with the personal hiking guide for some technical information for the next days. Welcome dinner and overnight.

Day 2: Trekking on the Carega

After breakfast we will reach the village of San Giorgio (1.540 mt) on the **Carega Mountain**.

The first part of the track is a comfortable flat forest road with gradually increasing slope, then a steep path down to the coast through dense forest to the **Passo Pertica**. At the refuge *Scalorbi*, you can enjoy the panoramic view of the **Recoaro valley**. Here we will have our lunch stop, enjoying a traditional meal.

Return to the hotel by bus and possibility to stop for a *Cimbri* products tasting. Back to the hotel.

Approximately 3 hours walk, level of difficulty: easy (for excursionists).

Day 3: Trekking on the Monte Baldo

After breakfast start for the daily route that will run along the ridges to the south in a succession of rocks, gullies, steep slopes and spectacular views. The vegetation is absent and contrasts with the green and flowering of the lower slopes of **Monte Baldo**. Three hours' walk to reach the refuge Telegraph erected in a high mountain scenery.

Packet lunch. We can comeback by taking the cable car for the descend.

Back to the hotel relax and free time. Overnight.

Approximately 3 hours walk, level of difficulty: easy (for excursionists).

Day 4: Hiking on Verona hills

After breakfast we will reach **Avesa**, in Verona neighbourhood. Go through a dirt road we will quickly reach **Vaio Borago**, here the dense vegetation and the real path begin. After a little “more than an hour's” walk we reach the end of the canyon, which high rock walls rise in a semicircle. The path from here is easier, passing through more open and sunny environments, local roads and mule tracks.

In the early afternoon after a quick packet lunch you will drive to Sirmione one of the ancient fortified town of Lake Garda. Free time to relax and shopping. Back to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

Approximately 4 hours walk, level of difficulty: medium (for excursionists).

Day 5: Verona & the Wine

After the breakfast you will start a private city tour for discover the beautiful Verona, see its enchanting streets and unique monuments. You will admire the magnificent **Arena di Verona** and visit one of the most romantic place in the world: **Juliet's Balcony**. After some time free and lunch. By early afternoon we will go to the most prestigious wine region ,the Valpolicella, for a wine tour and a product tasting session. An explanation of wine, vineyard, the cellar were the grapes dried for Amarone, the visit end with a tasting of the home made products always combined with a few picks.

Returning to the hotel, free time and overnight.

Suggestion: *What you can do in your free time in Verona:*

- ✓ Visit Castelvecchio museum
- ✓ Visit the Roman Theatre and reach Castel San Pietro
- ✓ Go shopping in Via Mazzini and Corso Porta Borsari

Day 6: Departure

Last cappuccino or espresso before goodbye. After breakfast transfer to the airport for your return flight.

Clothing suggestions: trekking/hiking shoes, tracksuit, jacket/k-way, comfortable and waterproof clothes, hat, sunscreen.
